Application Method

Application of the two-part formula will bring tired and weathered looking teak back to life. It is designed to work quickly and effectively to bring a light coloured 'just sanded' look without the time and cost usually associated with teak renovation. Also effective for removing fuel stains, fish blood and rust from teak. Teak Deck Cleaner can be used for removing seagull droppings, food / drink stains, teak oils and varnish.

Instructions

Part 1: Cleaner

1. Wearing protective gloves and eye wear, apply cleaner to a wet deck in areas of 1m square.
2. Cleaner should be diluted in a bucket with water at a dilution rate of at least 2:1 (2 = water) depending on severity of staining. For lightly soiled decks dilute with up to 10 parts water. For heavily weathered decks use 5:1.
3. Using a sponge / mop, spread evenly and allow the area to darken to a uniform dark brown.
4. Once the teak has turned dark brown, hose off the treated teak until the water running off is completely clean (keep product off aluminium and other metals).

Part 2: Renovator

1. Using renovator and a separate sponge / mop, apply the exact same method as the cleaner making sure you cover the whole treated area with the product.
2. When applied the teak will lighten to a uniform 'nutty brown' colour almost instantly.
3. Again hose off the areas treated with the renovator until all the product has been removed.
4. Now the deck will be a lovely fresh, even light brown colour like new teak.
5. You must avoid contaminating the products by mixing or using the same mop / sponge as they will neutralise each other and become ineffective.
